The Club contains a Grill Room, Patio and Dining Room for Luncheon and Dinner. The following are the “in season” clubhouse dining hours.

There will be no food service available in the Marine Lounge on special member functions, such as Luau, Formals, Dinner Dances, etc.

You may also order Luncheon from the menu from our Poolside Waitress. This service is limited to luncheon hours and is available most in-season days. Your food and beverage checks will be presented to you by the server to be signed with your name and account number. The Club holds a “No Tip” policy. Also, adjacent to the pool area, we have the Snack Bar. Purchases at the Snack Bar may be made with Ticket Books, available at the Snack Bar or charged to your account. No loose tickets are accepted for purchase.

Function space is available to you and your family for private parties. We offer a wide selection for Luncheon, Dinner, Brunch or Hors d’oeuvres Parties. We can facilitate either a small intimate party or a large celebration. All arrangements may be made through the Clubhouse Manager.

RESERVATIONS

During the summer season Lunch and Dinner hours can become quite busy. So that we may better serve you, reservations are recommended whenever possible.

When making reservation arrangements for club events, we request the following:

Names of all members seated at the tables.

Number of non-member guests seated at the table.

No single table to exceed 12 people.

All add-ons and any reservation changes must be done through the member who initially made the table arrangements.

Reservations are always required, especially for any special event. (i.e. Dinner Dances, Cookouts, etc.)

Cancellations will be accepted up until twenty-four hours prior to the event. There will be a charge to any member who has a reservation and does not attend the event.

No “doggie bags” will be allowed on any type of buffet served. No exceptions!

DRESS CODE

The following is the Club’s “Dress Code” policy:

Formal Men - Black Tie (Tuxedos)
Ladies - Appropriate Formal Evening Attire

Informal Jackets and Ties for men and comparable attire for ladies

Casual Collared shirts and slacks for men - no jackets or ties required. For women, dress appropriate for the occasion, such as sun dresses, halters, slacks or skirts.

Sports Attire Appropriate golfing, tennis or yachting attire. No golf shoes, bathing suits or bare feet allowed in the Clubhouse or on the Patio at any time.

This rule will be strictly enforced by the Management. You will be asked

to leave the area in question if not in the proper attire.

Dining Room and Ballroom.....Casual dress on Saturday night,
or as specified in the newsletter.

Grill Room, Marine Lounge,
and Patio.....Sports attire permissible, or as specified
in the Newsletter. Any attire more
formal than sportswear always
acceptable in these areas.

GUEST RULES

Your guests are always welcome for lunch, dinner, and most clubhouse events. Signing in of guests in the Guest Book in the Foyer is mandatory.

Guests for golf, tennis, and pool are limited to once a month or three consecutive times in a month, not to exceed (5) five times in a year for the same guest. There is a fee involved and one must sign in his/her guest in the appropriate area.

The above Guest Rule also applies to both Duplicate Bridge and Luncheon Bridge.

LOCKER ROOMS

Facilities at the club include a Men's Locker Room, Ladies' Locker Room, Girls' Locker Room and a Boys' Locker Room. To make arrangements for rental of the lockers, please contact the Manager. If you do not wish to rent a locker, you may still use the Locker Rooms.

Children under 18 are not allowed in the Men's and Ladies' Locker Rooms.

FINANCIAL

Our Fiscal Year begins the 1st of January of any given year and ends the 31st of December. Dues are posted to your account on the 1st of January and may be paid in full during the first month, or are billed monthly.

Kindly be advised that there is a “Minimum” to be spent in food and beverage in House during any given fiscal year. You will be notified of your minimum amount, reflective of your membership category, on your initial statement. If the Minimum is not met by the end of specific period, you will be charged the balance of that minimum amount.

Monthly statements are computed on the last day of the month of all charged incurred during that period. Statements are payable by the last banking day of that month. If payment is not received by the required date, you are considered delinquent. Your statement shall be noted. If payment is not received by the 15th of the following month, your privileges will be revoked.
